OUR YEAR

Letter from our Executive Director

Dear LOVEboldly Community,

What a year it was! Despite the trials and devastations Ohio's LGBTQIA+ community, particularly the Transgender community, experienced, 2023 was a banner year for

LOVEboldly. We continued to bring in larger amounts of donations, educate more people, partner with more congregations and organizations, and have a larger impact on the LGBTQIA+ and faith communities in Ohio and beyond.

In February, we achieved our long-term goal of becoming a majority LGBTQIA+ person-led organization. We continue to work to bring on additional LGBTQIA+ board members to ensure LOVEboldly remains led and directed by LGBTQIA+ Christians with the dedicated support of passionate cisgender and heterosexual allies. I would be remiss not to say that the impetus to becoming an LGBTQIA+ person-led organization arose from and was coordinated by our board members, who are allies. They did the hard work first so that LGBTQIA+ Christians could flourish and, in turn, help other LGBTQIA+ people flourish.

During 2023, we continued our important work of educating ministry leaders and equipping congregations. Through 34 sponsored or co-sponsored programs, LOVEboldly reached almost 1,000 people and impacted even more in one-to-one and small group meetings. We added four new Church Partners and began to develop closer relationships with congregations in Ohio, Tennessee, Alabama, Michigan, Indiana, and Florida. Moving into 2024, a grant from Christ Church Cathedral in Cincinnati will allow us to launch the inaugural cohort of the LOVEboldly Fellows Program for heterosexual and cisgender clergy who are seeking intentional education and coaching on working with the LGBTQIA+ community.

Through a generous grant received at the end of 2022, we were able to engage Rev. Brandan Robertson, a noted pastor, public theologian, and author, as a consultant and communications coordinator. Brandan was able to bring in several "big name" speakers and increase LOVEboldly's profile on social media.

LOVEboldly was increasingly recognized as a voice for Queer Christians and Queer people of faith in general in 2023. We were called upon to lend expertise and our collective lived experience in more spaces, including at the Ohio Statehouse and in the media. We published op-eds, provided testimony before various House and Senate committees, joined multiple organizational letters, and even joined an *amicus curiae* brief filed with the Ohio Supreme Court.

Yet for all our success, the work continues on all fronts. We give thanks to our gracious and empowering God for all the blessings of 2023 and we also thank you, our supporters, donors, volunteers, partners, and community for all that you brought to this movement.

Programming


During 2023, we expanded from webinars only and reintroduced more in-person events, including events cosponsored with Church Partners and other organizations.

34 Programs During 2023


Average attendance at each program



Looking Ahead to 2024

LOVEboldly Fellows Program

With support from a grant from Christ Church Cathedral (Episcopal - Cincinnati, OH), LOVEboldly will launch a nine-month cohort learning experience for cisgender and heterosexual pastors, ministry leaders, and graduate seminarians. The inagural cohort will launch in March 2024 with ten fellows.

(In)Decent Faith: Conversations on Queerness and Spirituality


