He is writing his dissertation on the leadership of LGBTQ+ Christians in church spaces.

Brought up in the Roman Catholic Church, Ben has always been active in the church in various roles, particularly in music. He joined the Episcopal Church in college and has attended a variety of congregations coming to consider the gray area between the Episcopal Church and the United Church of Christ to be his theological home. 


## Our Webinars & Events

#### **Devoted Conference**


